Please include a 3 x 5 card with your name, age, address, phone number, e-mail address, name of school and private teacher. A non-refundable audition fee of \$15 must be paid by check, made payable to SMA. Students may choose their own repertoire. Be sure to include the composer and title of your piece(s). To be judged, you **MUST AGREE TO PERFORM, IF SELECTED, ON THE WINNERS' RECITAL MARCH 29**.

Final Round: Live performance by selected finalists will be held **Sunday, February 5**, 3:30 p.m. at Trinity Lutheran Church, 1400 West Stadium Blvd. Performers are responsible for providing their own piano accompanist. Judges may determine that the March 29 concert will showcase two or more prize winners. Prizes will be awarded at the concert.
